

The results of the 41st International Fine Arts Meeting for Children and Youth “My Adventure in the Museum”

In 2019, **16 museums** conducted regional stages of the competition, implementing the following tasks:

- promotion of the idea of the International Meeting among various institutions involved in fine arts education of children and youth (schools, community centres, and art studios)
- collection of works from various institutions
- execution of the jury’s proceedings
- organisation of the exhibition
- preparation and execution of special award ceremonies, with awards given to the most outstanding young artists.
- delivery of the artworks (from **155 institutions** in total) to the District Museum.

Aside from the museums, 35 other institutions and 3 individuals submitted works for the competition, which meant that artworks were received from:

- **12 community centres**
- **18 schools**
- **5 institutions of other type (an after-school activity centre, a psychological and pedagogical counselling centre, and art galleries)**
- **3 individuals**

In total, 8 thousand artworks were created for the regional stage of the competition.

1030 works from Poland, Serbia, Czech Republic and China (Hong Kong) were submitted for the final stage of the *41st International Meeting* by altogether 190 institutions.

On July 8, the jury chose 180 works for the post-competition exhibition which will be opened to public on 10 September 2019 and housed at the District Museum in Toruń in the building of the Old Town Hall.

The jury decided to grant 19 equal awards. In addition, the following special awards were also granted: two Awards of the Mayor of the City of Toruń, two Awards of the Director of the District Museum in Toruń, the Award of the Society of Friends of the District Museum in Toruń, as well as the award for creating innovative artistic solutions and outstanding achievements in the process of cultural education of children and youth.

An audience plebiscite will be carried out during the exhibition. Member of public will be able to vote in person at the museum exhibition in Toruń and cast their votes on-line. This voting process will allow to select award winners in various age groups. One award per every age category, that is: authors aged 5-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, and 16-18, with an additional award for disabled children and youth. All works included in the exhibition will be made available on the Internet at www.muzeum.torun.pl on 10 September 2019, that is, on the opening day of the exhibition. The plebiscite will run from 10 September to 6 October 2019.
